Lyle Edwin Goodnight, 88 passed away Sunday, June 12, 2016 at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born on January 8, 1928 in Michigantown, a son of the late Lacey Emerson and Doris Irene (Ferguson) Goodnight.

He was a 1946 graduate of Lebanon High School. Following high school he served in the Indiana National Guard from 1948 – 1952

Lyle was married at the Mud Creek United Presbyterian Church in Boone County on November 22, 1950, to Rosemary Ellen (Morton) Goodnight. Mrs. Goodnight passed away on April 22, 2007.
