March 25, 1954 - January 14, 2016

Marcia Sue Canada Bruce died in Denver Colorado on January 14, 2016 after a long and arduous battle with a progressive neurological disorder.

She was born March 25, 1954 to the late Betty (Young) and Malcolm Canada. She was preceded in death by her grandparents, Ruth (Ferguson) and Ralph Canada, Nina (Stanley) and Marion Young as well as her father-in-law Harry Bruce and sister-in-law Kathleen Bruce.

She is survived by her husband of 34 years, Stephen (Steve) Bruce, three children, Susan, Scott and Katie and her mother-in-law, Patricia (Patty) Bruce of El Paso, TX. During the summers of 1971 and 1972 she worked at Witham Memorial Hospital in the Medical Record Department. She was a member of Rainbow for Girls where she served as Worthy Advisor of the Thorntown chapter.

She graduated from Thorntown High School in 1972, where she was a flag twirler in the Marching Band. She attended Indiana University where she earned a degree in Health

Information Management. She ultimately became a Registered Record Administrator.

Marcia's first career experience was Director of Medical Records in the hospital in Clarksburg, West Virginia.

She then moved to El Paso, Texas where she met and married Steve. She continued her career in Health Information Management and they moved to Tucson, Arizona where she worked with Hospice. Immediately prior to her death they lived in Santa Fe, New Mexico.
