Margaret (Peabody) Dougherty, 91, passed away Saturday morning, April 22, 2017, at Suncoast Hospice Mid Pinellas Care Center in Pinellas Park, Florida. She was born in Lebanon, Indiana, on August 18, 1925, a daughter of the late Charles Leslie and Wava (Dickerson) Peabody.

On April 8, 1964, Margaret was married to Barclay M. Dorset in New York City. Mr. Dorset passed away in 1970. In November 1976, she married Noble Dougherty in Pocono, Pennsylvania. Mr. Dougherty passed away in 1983.

She was a 1943 graduate of Pinnell High School, attended Ball State University for one year, and later graduated from Florida Atlantic University in 1985. She had lived in Los Angeles, California from 1949 until 1960 when she moved to New York City. From there, she moved to Canyon City, Colorado in 1966. She was back in Lebanon for a while before heading to New Jersey where she worked at Fairleigh Dickinson University as the Assistant to the Director of Videos and Movies from 1992 to 2001. At that point she retired to Florida where she had since resided.

Margaret was a member of Old Union Church in rural Jamestown, Indiana and the Order of Eastern Star of Lebanon.

She was a devoted mother and grandmother and took pride in her family. She

enjoyed reading, knitting and gardening.

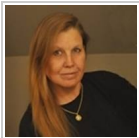
