Mrs. Margaret Charlotte "Peg" Mohler, 95, passed away on Sunday, December 27, 2020 at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana.

Peg was born April 21, 1925, in Chicago, Illinois; a daughter of the late Herman and Margaret Nordlinger.

She married Marshall Allen Mohler on June 25, 1949, in West Lafayette. He preceded her in death on March 30, 2010.

Peg graduated from high school in Chicago and received her bachelor's degree from Purdue University in Home Economics. Peg taught home economics at Valparaiso University for a few years and later worked in the sales department for Amana Radar Ranges.
