Marilee M. Frandsen passed away at Homewood Health Campus on April 23, 2016, following a brief illness. She had resided at Crown Pointe of Lebanon for several years.

She was born on November 8, 1929, in Peoria, Illinois, the daughter of Kent L. Macy and Isabel (Barger) Macy, both deceased. She was married for 39 years to G. Kent Frandsen, who passed away in November 1988.

She is survived by her three children, Kent (Charlotte) Frandsen of Lebanon, Jeff Frandsen of Zionsville, and Anne (Tony) Boone of Lebanon, and grandchildren, Alicia Frandsen (Will) Harrelson of Troy, Ohio, Andrew Frandsen of Indianapolis, and Brock Boone and Parker Boone of Lebanon. Two grandchildren preceded her in death, John Whitney Roth III and Jake Roth. She is also survived by a brother, Barger L. (Betty) Macy of Fishers, Indiana.

Mrs. Frandsen attended Bradley University before marrying her husband in 1949. They lived in Normal, Illinois until 1959 when her husband's employment as a school book salesman was transferred to Indiana. They made Lebanon their home thereafter. She was primarily a homemaker for her family although she worked for Ken Rockstroh, CPA, was a teacher's aide at Harney Elementary, and co-owned a monogram business with Jane Milburn.

Mrs. Frandsen was a member of St. Peter's Episcopal Church and Centenary United Methodist Church as well as Pi Beta Phi Sorority, Tri Kappa, Ulen Country Club, Magazine Club, Bicycle Club and several local Bridge clubs. She also was one of the founding members of Symphony at Sunset Group.

She was long devoted to her family and enjoyed hobbies of Bridge, sewing, and reading.
