Mr. Marion Eugene Wilhoite, 86 years old, passed away on February 24, 2015, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born on July 18, 1928, in Boone County to the late Faye Edgar and Ruby Ellen (Miller) Wilhoite.

A life-resident of Boone County, Marion graduated from Kirklin High School in 1948. Following high school, he served his country honorably in the United States Navy.

On September 7, 1952, he was married to Elloise Dare (Abbitt) Wilhoite, in Boone County. Mrs. Wilhoite passed away on May 11, 2012. They had spent 59 loving years together.

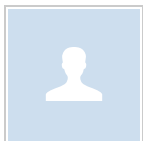
