Mrs. Martha Jane Ottinger, 90, of Thorntown passed away on Friday, July 3, 2015, at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis. She was born in Lebanon, Indiana, on September 28, 1924, the daughter of the late William and Grace (Lang) McKinsey.

She was a 1942 graduate of Lebanon High School.

On June 25, 1948, she was married to Donald Marion Ottinger in Thorntown, Indiana. Mr. Ottinger passed away on August 20, 2008.

Martha worked as an office administrator for several different companies. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and most recently attended the Methodist Church, both in Thorntown. She was a longtime supporter of the Thorntown Little League and WEBO Athletics. Martha volunteered at the Sugar Creek Art Center as a greeter and was an auxiliary member of the American Legion Post 218 in Thorntown as well as the Thorntown Alumni Association.
