Mary Alice Jackson, 87, passed away on Friday, July 20, 2018, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born in Montezuma, Indiana on April 23, 1931, a daughter of the late Harry Leonard and Maude Lucille (Kennedy) Van Hook.
