Max Leon Spear, 92, of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away Wednesday, November 7, 2018, at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis. He was born on December 4, 1925, in Frankfort, Indiana; a son of the late Clyde and Edith (Vinard) Spear.

Raised in Frankfort, Max was a 1943 graduate of Frankfort High School.

On January 13, 1944, he was married to Ruth (Jeffries) Spear; she survives. They shared over 74 loving years together.

Max worked 30+ years for Chrysler Corporation in Indianapolis, retiring in the early 1980s as Quality Control Engineer.

In addition to his parents, Max was preceded in death by two sisters, Bea Allen and Ina Mae Haynes.
