Doris Maxine Houchens, 93, passed away on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at Crown Point Senior Living in Lebanon. She was born in Montgomery County, Indiana on June 21, 1923, a daughter of the late Hugh Ezra and Mary Ellen (Glascock) Rankin.
