Michael Joseph Aubuchon, 42, passed away at his home in Frankfort on Saturday, December 26, 2015, after a brief battle with stomach cancer. He was born in Gary, Indiana, on February 18, 1973, to Judith Louise (Scubelek) Aubuchon of Rensselaer and the late Lawrence Joseph Aubuchon.

Michael moved to Rensselaer and graduated from North White High School in 1991. He attended Ivy Tech and Saint Joseph's College.

He worked as a security officer at Saint Joe before becoming a patrolman with the Rensselaer Police Department. Recently, he attended the First Church of the Nazarene in Frankfort.

He had a strong love of the Chicago Cubs, the Peanuts cartoon characters, and the music of Shannon Hoon, Blind Melon, Led Zeppelin, and Pink Floyd. A self-taught musician, he enjoyed playing and collecting guitars.
