Michael “Mike” Keith Click, 80, passed away Thursday, September 16, 2021, at Life’s Journey Hospice in Avon, Indiana. He was born in Lebanon, Indiana on September 25, 1940; a son of the late Wayne Lawrence and Bette Ann (Armstrong) Click.
