Michael Edward Paddack, 69, of Lebanon, passed away Sunday, April 19, 2015, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon. He was born in Lebanon, Indiana, on January 23, 1946, a son of the late Harry Edward and Emma Helen (Clemens) Paddack.

A life-long resident of Lebanon, he was a graduate of Lebanon High School. Following school, he enlisted in the United States Navy where he was stationed on the USS Roosevelt and the USS John F. Kennedy. He served his country honorably for four years.
