Milford Paul Scott, 85, of Lebanon and Frankfort, passed away on Thursday, August 31, 2017, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born in Lebanon on June 20, 1932, one of thirteen children to the late Emmitt and Ruth Scott.

Milford served in the United States Army as a military policeman during the Korean War. He served his country honorably from 1947 to 1951.

In March 1950, he was married to Bonnie Estelle (Sloan) Scott in Lebanon. She passed away in December 1965. He was then married to M. Marie (Duncan) Gilbert Scott on July 12, 1976 in Camden, Missouri. She preceded him in death as well.

Following his time in the service, Milford worked as a farm hand in Portland, Tennessee. He then returned to Indiana and was employed by the Yellow Cab Company, operating a taxi cab from 1960 to 1966. In 1968 he moved to Pompano Beach, Florida where he worked retail for Sears. He retired in 1982 and returned to Indiana, settling in Frankfort. In Frankfort, he helped as a cook in the kitchen at the Eagles Lodge from 1988 to 1994.

He was a member of the VFW in Lebanon, Eagles Lodge in Frankfort, and the Masonic Lodge in Burlington.
