Mitchell Julian Vogel, 88, of Onekama, Michigan and formerly of Rockville, Indiana, died Monday, March 14, 2016, at home. He was born May 27, 1927, in Indianapolis, the son of Mitchell and Sarah (Overman) Vogel.

Mitchell was a Veteran of World War II, serving in the US ARMY and he later served in the National Guard. Mitchell was a graduate of Purdue University, afterwards he worked in the scholastic jewelry business for over 33 years. He then worked for Emergency Management in Rockville for ten years until retiring in 1999.

Mitchell was an avid stamp and coin collector for many years and gave all of his grandchildren a set of the state quarters in hopes of getting them interested in collecting as well. He also loved swimming and even refereed several swim meets. Mitchell was a member of the Onekama Lions Club, and the Masonic Lodge in Indianapolis.

On May 11, 2001, Mitchell married Mary Ann Burns, who survives him. He is also survived by: ten children, Emily Vogel of Chicago, Illinois, Mitchell R.
