After a long and brave battle with cancer, Nancy Sue Hummel, of Lebanon, IN, passed gently into the arms of Jesus on March 20, 2025, surrounded by family members at Witham Memorial Hospital.

Nancy was born on Sept. 1, 1957, the youngest child of Betty and Stanley (Stryke) Strychalski of Lebanon, IN, where she spent her entire life.

Nancy graduated in 1975 from Lebanon High School and was married in 1982 to Larry Hummel. The couple were married for 38 years, prior to Larry's passing in 2020.

behind her two beloved cats, Callie and Brownie, who already miss her greatly.

She was preceded in death by her beloved mother, Betty Strychalski; her father, Stanley Strychalski; her husband, Larry Hummel; her sister, Janet Meece; and her brother-in-law, Stanley Meece.
