



## Olivia DeLaRosa

March 30, 1922 - August 20, 2022

Mrs. Olivia DeLaRosa passed away Saturday, August 20, 2022, at her home in Lebanon, Indiana. She was 100 years old, born March 30, 1922, in Pharr, Texas, one of seven children of the late Refugio and Anita (Avila) Guajardo.

On April 24, 1945, in Pharr, Texas, she was married to Miqueas “Mike” DeLaRosa. They had celebrated sixty-seven years of marriage before he passed away on February 18, 2012.
