Mrs. Patricia “Pat” J. Gann, 91, loving wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Monday, December 23, 2024, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon. She was born on August 28, 1933, in Indianapolis, Indiana, to the late Virgil Ottinger and Eunice (Muston) Ottinger.

Pat grew up on farms in New Augusta, Pittsboro and Jamestown, Indiana, which allowed her to cultivate her love of gardening, cooking and baking. Feeding others became her love language.
