Mrs. Patricia Ann Heidlebaugh, 73, passed away at her home in Jamestown surrounded by her loving family on Saturday, September 26, 2015. She was born in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 18, 1942, the daughter of the late Alvin F. and Loretta J. (McCray) French.

Pat was raised and educated in Indianapolis where she was a graduate of St. Ann's Catholic School.

On August 19, 1963, she was married to Robert V. Heidlebaugh in Maywood, Indiana; he survives.

Pat attended nursing school at Marion County General Hospital where she became an RN. She retired from Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon after twenty-five years of service. Following retirement, she was an Oblate of St. Benedict at Our Lady of Grace Monastery.

She was an active member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Lebanon and the Westside Carvers Club in Danville. Pat loved her family and enjoyed sewing in her free time.

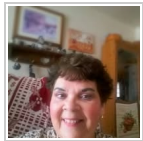
