Patricia Anita (White) Hine Schrock, 84, of Lebanon, passed away in the presence of family on Saturday, April 2, 2016 at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis, Indiana. She was born in Crown Hill Cemetery in Indianapolis on May 9, 1931, a daughter of the late George Franklin and Anna Anita (Mills) White.

She graduated from Shortridge High School in 1949.

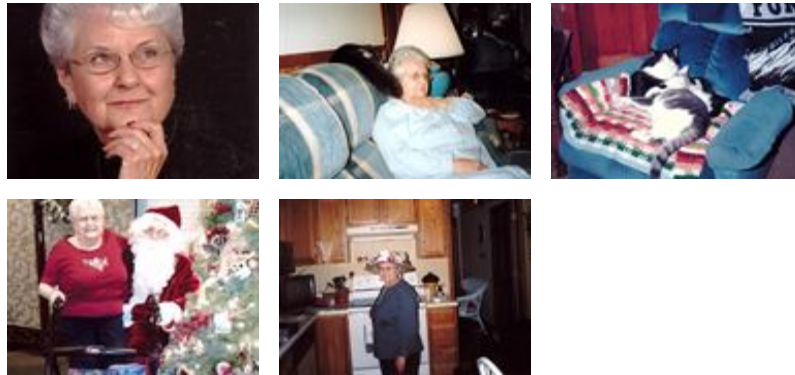
