



Pauline "Polly" G. McKinney

January 12, 1925 - December 4, 2022

Mrs. Pauline G. "Polly" McKinney, 97, passed away on Sunday, December 4, 2022, at The Waters of Lebanon. She was born in Marion, Ohio, on January 12, 1925, the youngest child of the late Charles E. and Cora E. (Quick) Gray.

Pauline was first married to Raymond George and they divorced. She later married William Ewell McKinney on March 17, 1956, in Aurora, Indiana. He preceded her in death on April 10, 1997.

A longtime resident of Ohio, Polly had worked as a bookkeeper for GTE of Ohio and Marion Steam and Shovel. She moved to Lebanon, Indiana in the early 1950s and worked in the office at the Blue & White Truck Stop and for Citizens Bank as a teller.

She was a member of the Lebanon Bible Baptist Church. In addition, she served with the American Legion and V.F.W. Women's Auxiliaries in Lebanon.
