March 26, 1951 - April 19, 2015

Raymond C. Everett, Jr., 64, of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away on Sunday, April 19, 2015. He was born on March 26, 1951, in Birmingham, Alabama, the son of the late Raymond Sr. and Jessie Elizabeth (Webster) Everett.

On March 17, 1977, he was married to Marie-Beatrice (Urban) Everett in Birmingham; she survives.

Raymond attended Springdale High School in Tarrant City, Alabama.

In 1996 he moved to Lebanon, where he was self-employed as a painting contractor.

Raymond was a devoted husband, father and brother. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, watching movies, painting, and was an animal lover. He was a member of the First Church of the Nazarene in Lebanon and a former Lebanon Elks member.

“As I watched Raymond's health deteriorate over the years and his ability to enjoy life as we do wash away, it broke my heart. He could no longer come and go as he pleased, he could no longer enjoy the things he loved doing; socializing was completely dependent upon the time others had to give him and he could no longer live in his own home. My heart ached when he would lie in his bed at the nursing home and say, "I don't want to be here, I want to go home." I knew there was nothing we could do to make that change. What amazed me was that in spite of all of this, Raymond endured the pain, the loss, the suffering with great patience and humility. He did not get angry. He never complained. He was so appreciative of every visitor and every bit of time spent with him. I can tell you however, that no one made his day like his wife Marie. I could spend hours with him but when she arrived in the room, he would perk up. There was almost a relief on his face knowing she was there; contentment. He watched her, listened to her every word and was grateful for the love and attention she gave him.

Raymond was often misunderstood. He could make inappropriate comments; but don't we all put our foot in mouth at times? He made his share of mistakes in life, but then again, don't we all? What I choose to remember about Raymond is how much he loved his wife, that he became a father to one who knew no father, that he loved animals, had creative abilities and truly had a generous spirit. As his brother Wayne said, "he would give you the shirt off his back."

No, maybe Raymond did not get to live life as we do, but he lived it the best he could and he impacted many lives in many ways.

Raymond, it was so hard to watch you suffer; at times it seemed unbearable. But now I rejoice in knowing that you are home with the Lord, encompassed in His love, visiting with relatives, meeting new people and moving about freely, constrained and limited by nothing. Praise the Lord, this life is not all there is. Praise the Lord for the shed blood of Jesus Christ that washes us clean and allows us the opportunity to spend eternity with a God who loves us more than we can fathom and gives us an eternal life that we cannot fully imagine. Thank God there is more to this life than the life spent in this world.

*Some of the last words spoken by Raymond, and he was not speaking to those of us at his bedside, were, "I'll follow you, I'll follow you." Just as the words sung by the Pastor the night you left us stated; you did not cross the Jordan alone.*

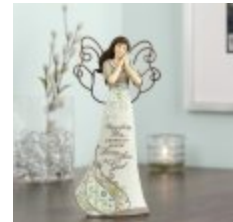
