Richard Byron Clouser, 81, passed away on Sunday, April 21, 2019, at Signature Healthcare of Parkwood in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born in Boone County, Indiana, on March 29, 1938, to the late Daniel Byron and Evelyn Blanche (Thompson) Clouser.
