Mr. Richard "Dick" Eugene Harmon, 76, formerly of Jamestown, Indiana, passed away at his home in Lebanon on Sunday, December 20, 2020. He was born in Lebanon on November 17, 1944, son of the late Ivan Eugene and Martha Virginia (Spaugh) Harmon.

On February 17, 1973, he was married to Jo Ann (Franklin) Harmon in Crawfordsville, Indiana; she survives.
