



## Richard Ray Weber

August 3, 1942 - January 28, 2018

On January 28th 2018, at 1:30 p.m., Richard “Dick” Ray Weber passed away quietly with family members surrounding him at the Roudebush Veteran's Hospital in Indianapolis, Indiana. Dick was 75 years old. He was preceded by his parents Bill and Doris Weber and by his daughter Katrina (Tina) Kay Weber Rikkets.

Dick is survived by his wife Juanita, son's Scott (Mitsue) Weber and Tim (Rachel) Weber, and daughter Doris (DeDe) Anderson. He is also is survived by two granddaughters (Kennedy and Abigail), five grandsons (Bradley, Nicholas, Willie, Daniel, and Colin), one great granddaughter, and four great grandsons.

Dick Weber grew up in Royalton, Indiana in Boone County with his two brothers Bill and Mike and went to school in Zionsville. He joined the Navy as a cook and married his sweetheart Juanita Lewis. He took his experience as a cook, when he left the Navy, to work for MCL Cafeterias in management, helping to create menus and open restaurants. Later he opened Weber's Appliance Center in Zionsville, Indiana and Linden, Indiana. He was a member of the Moose Lodge and a State Auditor for the Moose. In later years he moved to Rockville, Indiana and opened the Weber's Family Restaurant.

He was loved by many people. He was called dad or grandpa by many of the

people who worked for him because he treated them like family. He loved to fish and go camping. He liked to play Euchre and watch sports and tried to go to as many of his children's, grandchildren's and great grandchildren's sporting events as he could. He left a legacy of the importance of family and the love a family shares. The words that describe Dick Weber the most are "Love of Family".
