Mr. Robert K. Duncan, 79, passed away on Saturday, April 29, 2017 at his home in Lebanon. He was born on April 20, 1938 in Boone County, a son of the now late Earl and Ruth F. (Williams) Duncan.

Bob attended schools in Lizton and Danville. He graduated from Pinnell High School with the class of 1956 and was a member of the Pinnell Purple Dragons Basketball team. He was a member of the Indiana National Guard.

On May 13, 1959, he was married to Carol Dillon at the first Baptist Church in Lebanon and they had spent 58 years together.

Bob was employed for fifteen years at Pitman Moore/Dow Chemical in Zionsville.
