Taylor was born in Thorntown, Indiana on January 30, 1923, a son of the late Ralph V. and Bryul (Joseph) Taylor. He was a life-resident of Boone County, Indiana, with the exception of one year spent in Indianapolis. In 1923, he and his family returned to Thorntown and he graduated from Thorntown High School in 1942. Following school, Robert enlisted in the United States Army and served his country during World War II, having received the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart and Combat Infantry Badge. He was first married to Dorothy Arney and they divorced. On September 2, 1967, he was married to Myrtle L. (James) Taylor in Thorntown, Indiana. Mrs. Taylor passed away on March 3, 2001. Robert worked for the Hoosier Veterinary Laboratories in Thorntown for 25 years where he handled the hogs. He spent two years at the Streamline Trailer Company and thirteen years at Lau Blower where he retired in November 1988.
