Robert J. Hawkins, 62, passed away Monday, July 6, 2015 in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born in Evansville, Indiana, on April 4, 1953, a son of the late Lucille Elaine (Scott) and Charles Raymond Hawkins, Sr.

A longtime resident of Boone County, he was a 1971 graduate of Lebanon High School and received his business degree from IUPUI.

On January 14, 2015, he was married to Cynthia (Stabley) Mausteller Hawkins in Boone County; she survives.

Robert owned and operated Hawks Custom Flooring in Lebanon from 1979 – 2012. He was well known throughout the area for the quality of his workmanship.

In Advance, Indiana, Robert started an organization called We Care for the Kids and also began the first Cub Scout troop in Advance of which he was Cub Master for 13 years. He loved his family and friends and had many interests including fishing, camping, riding motorcycles and woodworking.
