Mr. Robert Ervin Miller, Jr., 89, passed away Wednesday, May 17, 2023, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon. He was born in Granite City, Illinois, on April 15, 1934, the only child of the late Alyce Marie (Earney) and Robert Ervin Miller, Sr.

On March 1, 1958, he was united in marriage to Alice Marie (Toth) Miller in Granite City, Illinois; she survives.

Robert served his country honorably in the United States Navy from February 1953–January 1955 aboard the USS Orion. He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He enjoyed his family, fishing, and gardening. Robert was a member of the Sons of the American Revolution in Fishers, Indiana.
