“Wow! I have for a long time tried to find Rex. We hadn't seen each other since probably 1979 or 80. Today, I ran across this sad news.

*When we were in Junior High and High School, Rex and I were the best of friends. We hung out all the time. My mom referred to him as one of her boys. We played basketball all the time. One summer, we challenged any of our friends to "2 on 2" matches. We played in Lebanon at the Boys Club, the park, on the court on Evans Street by the tracks, the Noblesville Boys Club, the Frankfort Boys Club, etc. By the end of the summer, we had made it 100 games played. We won 92 of them!!*

*I remember the 8 Tracks he had in his car which we would listen to on Friday nights when we'd go cruising. Some of the favorites were Grateful Dead, Boston, Steve Miller. Before we had drivers licenses, Rex and I would walk to Dominick's pizza on the square and share a BBQ pizza and listen to the juke box. I remember how we used to write notes to each other in class in school, but we used pictures to represent words so the note could not be understood by others. I recall how his Uncle Cleon would give us rides to and from the Boys Club in his pick-up truck. I recall how we used to get jealous of each other if our mom's made Coney dogs for dinner. We both loved the Gebhardt Coney sauce! Silly stuff, but I've shared many times with my wife the stories of my friendship with Rex. They are etched in my mind forever.*
