Ronald Paul Pedigo, 68, passed away Monday, April 8, 2024, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born in Lebanon, on November 18, 1955, a son of the late Richard Lee “Bud” Pedigo and Catherine “Kitty” (Lanham) Pedigo.
