Ronald Eugene Wynkoop, 68, passed away Tuesday afternoon, April 14, 2020, at Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born March 3, 1952 in Lebanon, a son of the late LeRoy Wynkoop and Mary Joanna (Sherrill) Wynkoop.
