Mrs. Sandra Kay Copenhaver, 80, passed away on Friday morning, April 22, 2022, at Ascension St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis. She was born in Hamilton County, Indiana, on September 8, 1941, a daughter of the late Robert L. and Beverly B. (Wolfe) Brown. After becoming a single working mother during wartime, Beverly decided it was best that Sandy be raised by her maternal grandparents, Herschel and Esther Wolfe in Boone County. Herschel and Esther's sons, Stanley, Donald, and Trevor "Max" became much like brothers to Sandy even though they were her uncles. Sandy was a 1959 graduate of Dover High School.
