Sharon "Sherry" Lee Murphy, 81, passed away Saturday, July 6, 2024, at Homewood Health Campus in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born in Lebanon, on January 15, 1943; a daughter of the late Cecil Harlan Loveless and Bessie Evelyn (Arnold) Loveless.

Sherry graduated from Thorntown High School in 1961.

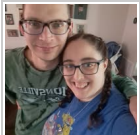
