



## Shirley E. Dehn

August 16, 1924 - June 29, 2016

Mrs. Shirley Elaine Dehn, 91, passed away on Wednesday, June 29, 2016, at her home in Lebanon. She was born in Schenectady, New York, August 16, 1924, a daughter of the late Edgar and Mabel L. (Bradt) Williams.

She was a 1943 graduate of Tech High School in Indianapolis, Indiana.

On May 18, 1946, she was married to George Walter Dehn in Indianapolis, Indiana; he survives.

Shirley had worked as a clerk for the Boone County Clerk's Office for many years until her retirement in 1988.

She was a dedicated and active member of St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Lebanon where she participated in the choir, Cursillo and the Altar Guild. She also served as a Sunday school teacher and Lay Eucharist Minister. Shirley was a member of the community choir, the Central Indiana Bicycle Association and was a Boy and Girl Scout Leader. In 1989, she and George volunteered for the Alaskan State Parks as a campground hostess.

A devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, Shirley loved her family dearly. She enjoyed poetry, biking, traveling and loved to sing, and had a wonderful sense of humor. Her husband was a driver for the Boone

County Senior Services where they enjoyed many trips together.

Funeral Services are to be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 2, 2016 at St. Peter's Episcopal Church, 950 East Washington Street, in Lebanon, Indiana, with Fr. Christopher R. Beasley officiating.

Visitation is planned from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m., Friday, July 1, 2016 and again from 10:00 a.m. until the time of service on Saturday, July 2, 2016, at the church in Lebanon.

Interment will be held at a later date at Oak Hill Cemetery in Lebanon, Indiana.

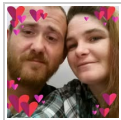
