



## Shirley A. Woody

Mrs. Shirley Ann Woody, 84, of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away Sunday night, July 16, 2017. She was born in Boone County, Indiana, on May 23, 1933, the daughter of the late Charles H. and Opal Marie (Smith) Thompson.

On September 19, 1954, she was married to Jon Leonard Woody at the Dover Christian Church. He passed away on November 24, 2004.

Shirley was a lifelong resident of Boone County. She was a 1951 graduate of Dover High School and had attended Purdue University for a year.

Shirley helped her husband with the family farm and volunteered at Witham Memorial Hospital for 34 years. She was an active member of Dover Christian Church. Shirley was a distinguished member of the Extension Homemakers and its various branches where she served as an officer and committee member on the local, district, state, and national level. She hosted several exchange Homemakers from various foreign countries and had traveled abroad a number of occasions as part of her work with the organization. She was an avid supporter and worker for the Republican party and was honored by the Indiana Federation of Republican Women for her outstanding service and leadership to the GOP. She was a member of the Boone County Republican Women's Club and had served as a two-term vice president for the IFRW, district director of Sen. Richard Lugar's re-election committee, a

vice precinct committee person and had volunteered on local and state committees through the years. Also, to her credit for community involvement and service, Mrs. Woody was honored by being named a Sagamore of the Wabash.

She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother and loved her family dearly.
