Mr. Stanley D. Bogan, 74, was welcomed into heaven on Saturday, December 5, 2020. He spent his final hours here on earth surrounded by family. He was born January 15, 1946 in Indianapolis, Indiana, a son of the late William L. and Gladys L. (Morton) Bogan.

He was a 1964 graduate of Lebanon High School. Following high school, he attended Tri-State University in Angola.

On July 2, 1987, he married Lynora "Lynn" (Strong) Bogan in Lebanon, Indiana; she survives.

organizations throughout the community. His greatest passion was spending time with his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.
