



## Suzanne Bramblett

March 5, 1931 - April 5, 2021

Mrs. Suzanne Bramblett, 90, passed away peacefully at home in Lebanon with family by her side on Monday, April 5, 2021. She was born in Indianapolis, Indiana on March 5, 1931, a daughter of the late Dr. Robert S. and Lois Ruth (Watkins) Ball.

Suzanne was a life resident of Boone County and had graduated from Lebanon High School. On November 30, 1951, she was married to Edward Dale Bramblett in Lebanon. They shared 43 loving years together before he passed away on January 1, 1995.

Suzanne had a long standing, close connection to Centenary United Methodist Church in Lebanon as her grandfather, Dr. J.R. Ball, was the Superintendence of Sunday school and her grandmother was the organist of the church.
