Thomas W. Richardson, 78, of Oro Valley, Arizona and formerly of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away in Tucson, Arizona on Monday, September 28, 2015. He was born on July 4, 1937 to the late Loel and Leah (Harris) Richardson.

He served 10 years in the US Navy from 1958 to 1968 as an Aviation Electronics 2nd Class Petty Officer making it as far away as Guam and Vietnam. After his military career he worked 25 years and retired from Indiana Bell as a Switching Technician in the main Indianapolis office building.

He loved and was greatly involved in 18th Century living-history reenactments for over 25 years where he handcrafted many of the authentic articles of clothing and items that he used.
