Velma Lois (King) Boone, 100, passed away on Monday, January 1, 2018 at Crown Pointe in Lebanon, Indiana. She was born on April 23, 1917 a daughter of the late Virgil and Jessie (Walker) King. Velma was one of eleven children with four surviving siblings; Ronald “Zeke” King, Jewell Haskett, Joan Brown and Phyllis Powell.
