Vera Adeline Farris, 95, of Lebanon, died Saturday morning, September 5, 2015 at Hickory Creek Nursing Home in Lebanon.

Mrs. Farris was born on March 29, 1920 in Davis City, Iowa, a daughter of the late Harley Robert and Ruby Ellen (Willis) Sly.

She was educated in Davis City, Iowa, where she graduated with the class of 1938.

She was married to William Farris in Spurgeon, Indiana on July 25, 1939. Mr. Farris died on November 2, 1995.

Vera had worked in food service at Harney Elementary School from 1970 – 1983. Prior to moving to Lebanon, she and her husband had operated Farris Southside Market in Oakland City, Indiana.

She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother. Her interests include craftwork and attending the First United Church of Christ in Lebanon where she served as a Sunday school teacher and sang in the choir.
