Jones was born on December 6, 1937, in Clearfield, Pennsylvania, the son of the late Victor Worrell and Ruth (Litz) Jones. As a resident of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, Vic was active in school sports. He participated in football and baseball and was a graduate of Clearfield High School in 1955. He was an outstanding athlete and was offered a football scholarship to any college throughout the United States. Vic chose to attend Indiana University where he was an outstanding Fullback for the Hoosiers. He completed undergraduate and graduate degrees in Education while at Indiana University. On July 1, 1961, in Monticello, Indiana, Vic was married to the love of his life, Linda Marie (Papworth) Jones. Vic's first teaching position was in Lebanon where he started teaching in the Elementary System and then in the High School for a total of thirty-six years. Early in his career, he established Physical Education Programs for the Lebanon Junior High School and the elementary schools in the Lebanon system. At Lebanon High School, Vic taught physical education, Health and Drivers education. In addition, he coached football, track and wrestling during his career. During his time as a coach, Vic was the recipient of numerous awards and recognitions for the successes of his athletes and teams including David Clark being the state wrestling champion in his weight class. Fishing and boating were on the list of Vic's enjoyments. He loved the family's lake house in LaFollette, Tennessee where they entertained their

family the past ten years. Vic's son, Todd, had worked to build the lake home for all to enjoy. Vic always followed the activities and sporting events of his two children. In addition, Vic took pride in attending grandchildren's sporting events and activities.
