Vincent Farrell Morrow, Sr., 85, passed away Saturday morning, May 6, 2017 at Witham Memorial Hospital surrounded by his loving family. He was born on December 21, 1931, in Ringgold, Louisiana, a son of the late James Denman and Mittie Viola (Armstrong) Morrow.

Vincent was a Korean War Veteran of the United States Army. He served his country honorably from 1951 – 1955.
