



W. Robert "Bob" Hood

Willis Robert "Bob" Hood died peacefully at home in Lebanon, Indiana, surrounded by his family on Saturday, September 30, 2023. He was 84 years old. Born June 25, 1939, in Mt. Vernon, Pine Hill, Kentucky, he was a son of the late Thomas and Ida (Turner) Hood.
