Mr. William Frederick Priesmeyer, Jr., 88, passed away Monday morning, December 18, 2023, at his home in Lebanon, Indiana. He was born in St. Louis, Missouri, on August 30, 1935, a son of the late William F. Priesmeyer, Sr. and Marie Ann (Witte) Priesmeyer.

On March 2, 1957, he was married to Dolores Fern (Vitale) Priesmeyer in St. Louis, Missouri. She preceded him in death just twelve days ago on December 6.

William was a graduate of McBride High School in St. Louis and then went on and graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree from Missouri School of Mines and Metallurgy. William served his country honorably in the US Army from 1954 to 1956. During that time awarded the Army of Occupation Medal (Germany) and a Good Conduct Medal. He worked as a Metallurgic Engineer
