Ms. Davidson had been raised and educated in Lebanon where she graduated from Lebanon High School in 1943. She then graduated from Ball State University with a B.S. in Education in 1948. She received her M.S. at Indiana University in Physical Education in 1958. She had additional studies at Indiana University beyond her master's degree. She was licensed to teach in health, driver's education, social studies and physical education. For forty years she taught junior high social studies and physical education, from 1948 – 1956 at Muessel Jr. High School and from 1957 – 1988 at Edison Jr. High School, both located in South Bend, Indiana. Wilma retired in 1988 and returned to Lebanon where she had since resided. She was a member of Centenary United Methodist Church in Lebanon, Audubon Society, the Boone County and Indiana State Teachers Associations, and Women of the Moose of Lebanon. Myers Mortuary and Boone County Crematory are entrusted with the arrangements for cremation. Graveside Services will take place at Oak Hill Cemetery in Lebanon at a later date.
