



Wink Jagers

August 23, 1942 - June 21, 2015

Winston C. "Wink" Jagers, 72, passed away at Witham Memorial Hospital on Sunday, June 21, 2015. He was born in Frankfort, Indiana on August 23, 1942, a son of the late Albert Ross and Mary Annette (Wessel) Jagers.

Raised and educated in Frankfort, he was a 1960 graduate of Frankfort High School.

On August 6, 1961, he was married to Karen Sue (Hitch) Jagers in Mulberry, Indiana; she survives.

Wink had a passion for cars. His first job was washing cars for a local dealership and at the age of 16, he sold his first car. In 1963, he moved to Zionsville and worked in sales at Pearson Ford. There he moved through the ranks and became the General Manager. In 1975, he moved back home to Frankfort and became the owner and operator of Jagers Chevrolet. Wink had an opportunity to move to Lebanon in 1983 where he began Jagers Chevrolet-Buick-GMC. Wink always had an active role in his family's dealership that continues today with his wife and sons.

He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. Wink enjoyed each relationship he had with his many friends through his church, his dealership and his community.

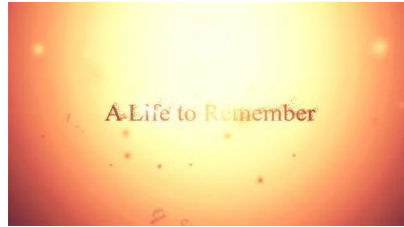
