Winnona Violet Steiner, 85, of Lebanon, Indiana, passed away at Majestic Care of Carmel, on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. She was born in Portland, Indiana, on November 2, 1938, a daughter of the late Alva Wood and Erma Josephine (McMinn) Wood.

Winnie attended Portland High School through her 11th grade year.
